

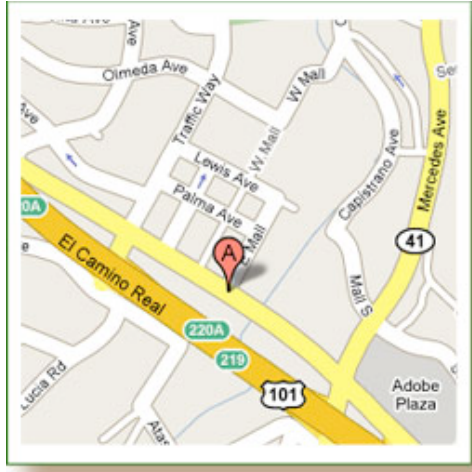
San Luis Obispo County Farmers Markets

Baywood Park – Downtown

2:00 – 4:30 PM

Baywood Park is a charming beach town next to Los Osos. The farmers market is held at 2nd & Santa Maria Streets by the bay.

Paso Robles – Downtown City Park

3:00 – 6:00 PM

Held in the City Park under the trees at 11th & Spring Streets.

Wednesday:

Arroyo Grande – Spencer’s Parking Lot – Courtland & E. Grand 8:30 – 1:00 AM

The Wednesday morning market has about 35 growers who collectively provide a good variety of in season vegetables, fruits, fish, and flowers. This market is located in the Spencer’s Fresh Markets parking lot. Having a farmers’ market in the parking lot of a grocery store makes it very convenient for shoppers. Customers can buy in season products at the farmers’ market and then go in Spencer’s to complete their weekly shopping needs. Directions: If coming from the 101 freeway, simply turn on Oak Park Blvd going away from Kmart, turn left on Grand Avenue, go one block and you are there!

Pismo Beach – Farmers Market at the Pier 5:00 – 8:00 PM

Every Wednesday evening from April thru September, enjoy a Farmers Market by the ocean. Great fresh fruit and vegetables. Start / stop dates tentative.

Atascadero – Downtown Sunken Gardens 3:00 – 6:00 PM

Directions: El Camino Real, 1/4 mile north of Highway 41 at the intersection of El Camino Real and East Mall.

Thursday:

San Luis Obispo Downtown 6:00 – 9:00 PM

The Thursday night SLO County Farmers' Market thrives year-round nestled in the heart of the charming San Luis Obispo downtown center. Every week this market draws over 10,000 market-goers and is one of the largest Farmers' Markets in the state of California. Approximately 70 farmers from all over the Central Coast and the San Joaquin Valley come out, week-after-week, to sell their fresh California seasonal produce to locals marketgoers and tourists alike. It includes live music, food and children's events. The farmers' booths span over 2 city blocks on Higuera Street, the main street through downtown SLO, between Osos and Nipomo Streets.

Morro Bay – Spencer’s Parking Lot – 2650 Main Street 2:30- 5:00 PM

The Morro Bay Farmers' Market smells of the ocean, but reaps the rewards of the land. Farmers from as far south as Goleta, east as Delano, and north as Salinas come to sell their goods at this Thursday afternoon market. This Morro Bay market is nestled just off of Highway 1, north of the Highway 41 junction. Held year round, except Thanksgiving.

Cambria – Vet’s Hall Parking Lot – 1000 West Main St.

Every Friday afternoon, local growers sell fresh-picked seasonal fruit, flowers. Trees and Plants. Fresh baked Italian pretzels (Taralli), biscotti, cookies, bread & more. Held year-round.

Paso Robles – Wal-Mart Parking Lot – S. River & Niblick Rd.

9:00 AM – 12:30 PM

Every Friday morning, local growers sell fresh-picked seasonal fruit, flowers, trees and plants.

Saturday:

Arroyo Grande - 215 Branch St., behind City Hall

Noon – 2:30 PM

As the roosters roam and crow around the Arroyo Grande City Hall building you really get the feeling of country at this downtown market. Artists are selling their wares by the creek-side and musicians fill the air with music. The setting couldn't be a more enticing venue to stroll through Farmers' Market and stock up for the week with the freshest and most abundant produce around. It's located right at the footbridge in old downtown Arroyo Grande, giving this country market a small urban-like feel.

Pismo Beach – Dinosaur Caves Park - Cliff Ave. & Shell Beach Rd.

Every Saturday through December, enjoy a great Farmers Market in a beautiful ocean-bluff park. Great fresh fruit and vegetables. Plus other vendors.

Morro Bay – 800 Block of Main Street, between Harbor & Morro 2:30 – 5:00 PM

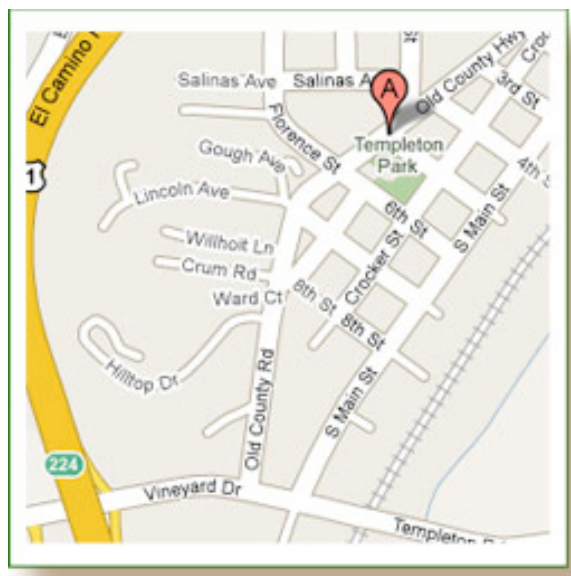
